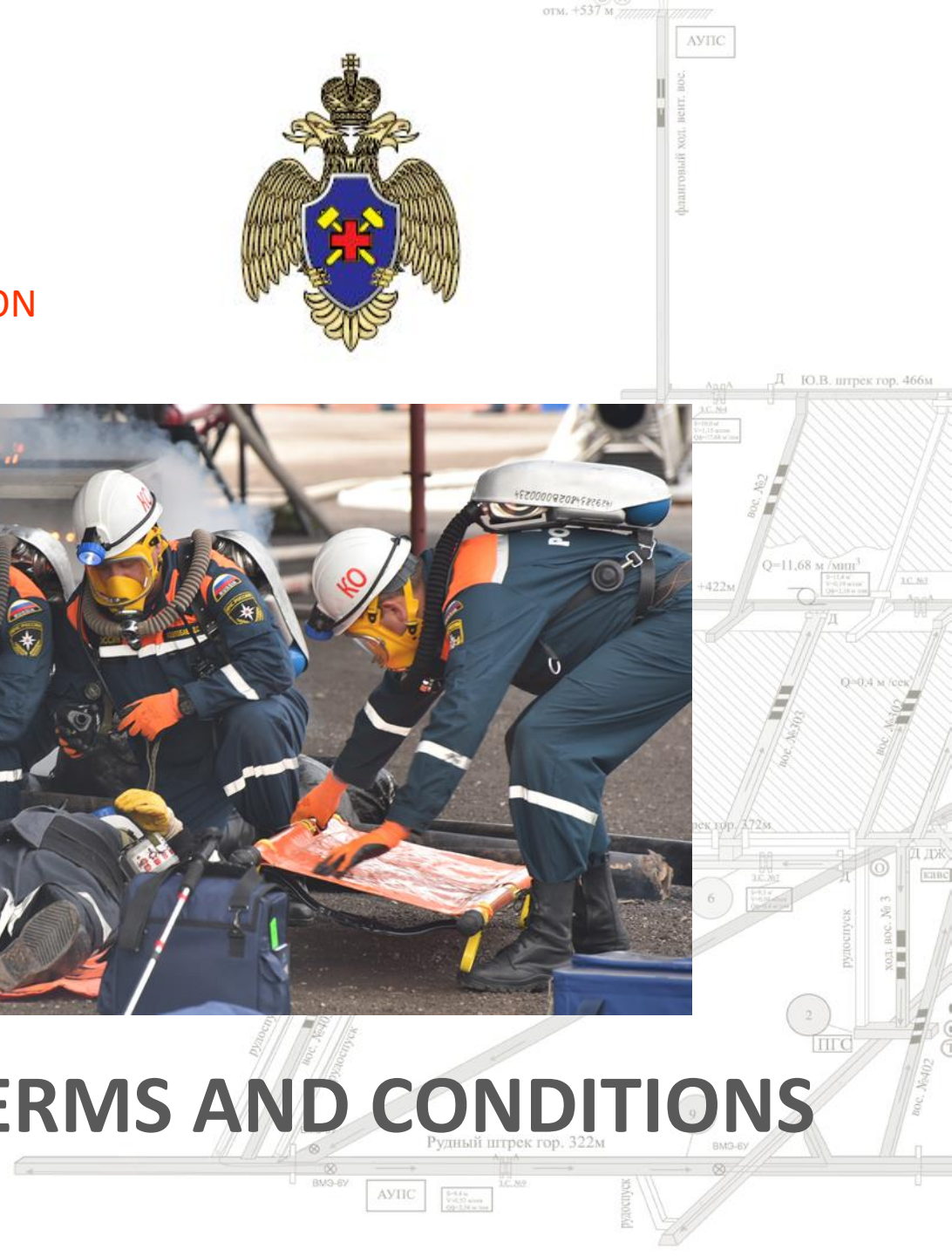

IMRC-2018 TERMS AND CONDITIONS





Participation in the IMRC-2018 implies agreement with the Terms and Conditions listed below.

1. Date and venue of the IMRC-2018:

1.1. The IMRC-2018 takes place from September 22-nd and September 29-th, 2018.

1.2. Registration and application for the IMRC-2018 starts on March 15-th, 2018. Final date of applications admission is May 31-st, 2018; registration approval - June 29-th, 2018.

1.3. Venues of the IMRC-2018:

Ekaterinburg, Ural State Mining University

Sverdlovsk region, areas of Berezovsky Mine, Ltd and «Urochishe» Open Pit Mine, Ltd.

EMERCOM of Russia facilities and other facilities, in accordance with the events program.

1.4. Official languages of the IMRC-2018 are English and Russian. Translation into other languages is not provided by the organizers.



2. Terms and conditions of participation:

2.1. Mine Rescuers (professionals and volunteers), specialists in mining, mines rescue work, and all interested parties are invited to participate in the IMRC-2018.

2.2. To participate in the IMRC-2018, you need to read the terms and conditions of participation, fill an application on the official website www.imrc2018.ru before May 31-st, 2018, and register before June 29-th, 2018, including registration fee payment.

2.3. The IMRC-2018 includes team and individual (obligatory and optional) contests.

The IMRC-2018 contests are following:

- Mine Rescue Simulation (team scoring)
- Firefighting (team scoring)
- First Aid (team scoring)
- Theory Exam (team scoring)
- Mine Rescue Relay Race (team scoring)
- Technician Contest (individual scoring)
- VR exercise (team scoring , optional)



2.4. The mine rescue team includes maximum 10 members (at the discretion):

- Mine rescue officer
- Team Captain
- Mine Rescuers – up to 6 people, including spare team members
- Technician
- Technical translator (if necessary)

2.5. The IMRC-2018 participants must strictly follow the IMRC-2018 Rules, the actual version (the IMRC-2018 Rules may be supplemented due to different factors), which will be available at the IMRC-2018 web-site www.imrc2018.ru.

2.6. Team members, participating in the IMRC-2018, must have insurance certificate and carry it for the period of IMRC-2018. The insurance certificate must cover the extreme sports activities.

2.7. Team members, participating in the IMRC-2018, have to pass medical examination and carry medical certificate during the IMRC-2018 events. The medical certificate, issued by doctor (general physician) and properly executed by the community standards, must prove authorization for mine rescue work.



2.8. Team members, participating in the IMRC-2018, must be properly trained and carry training certificate during the IMRC-2018 events. The training certificate must be issued by authorized person and meet the standards of team jurisdiction.

2.9. Team members, participating in the IMRC-2018, must be certified for mine rescue operations and carry qualification certificate during the IMRC-2018 events. The qualification certificate must be issued by authorized person and meet the standards of team jurisdiction.

2.10. Visitors, individual participants and guests of the IMRC-2018 can attend the competition contests at specially organized observation areas \ venues to look after team activities. Representatives of organizations and nations, whose teams participate in the IMRC-2018, are not allowed to attend at observation area before their teams started to perform. It's necessary to avoid information leakages.

2.11. Judges, approved by the IMRC-2018 Organizing committee, are on special conditions: no registration fees applied, meals and transfers provided.



2.12. Russia will be represented by 5 selected competing teams (max. 2 teams from organization guaranteed). Additional applications from Russian teams will be placed on the Competition Waiting List.

Each nation will be guaranteed 2 team entries (priority event entry is granted to teams from different organizations / regions of country), after which teams applying from that nation will be placed on the Competition Waiting List.

The deadline for application to receive a guaranteed national team entry is May 31-st, 2018 after which the Competition Waiting List Protocol will apply.

Teams that are not successful in receiving a guaranteed national team entry, will be placed on the Competition Waiting List, which will apply:

Remaining team entries, to the maximum of 30 teams, will be allocated to teams on the Competition Waiting List on a first-on first-in basis.

All International teams placed on the Competition Waiting List are automatically given higher priority than Russian teams.

Should all International applicants be satisfied and the maximum of 30 teams not be reached by June 1-st, 2018, entry to additional Russian teams on the Competition Waiting List will be offered on a first-on first-in basis.

All team selection procedures will be finalized on June 29-th, 2018.



3. The IMRC-2018 participation costs:

3.1. Price of participation in the IMRC-2018 depends on the chosen participant package, the date of registration. It constitutes:

	Registration before 15.04.2018	Registration after 15.04.2018
Team (to 10 members)*:	2 500 euro	3 500 euro
Spectator:	450 euro	600 euro

* - in case of the entry of Team from the Competition Waiting List, the amount of payment will be set according to the application date.

3.2. Registration fee includes:

- Admission to all events of IMRC-2018;
- Mine rescue equipment provision for teams (according to the rules);
- Transportation services according to the program;
- Excursion program (field trips and guided tours);
- Assistance in obtaining Russian visa (if necessary).



3.3. Accommodation and travel to\ from Ekaterinburg must be paid by participants additionally. It is necessary for participants to book the hotel at advance from the hotel list, posted on the IMRC-2018 web-site www.imrc2018.ru (section «Travel»). The way for booking require to note code word «IMRC-2018» in the booking application. It makes the possibility for participant to obtain the special price. All transfers are organized only from and to the hotels, listed at www.imrc2018.ru

Additional fees, not included in the program of the IMRC-2018, or fees connected with individual terms and conditions of participation, should be additionally paid by the Participant, from his/her own resources.

3.4. Cancellation policy:

- In case of cancellation before April 15-th, 2018 – no penalties (not including bank fees).
- In case of cancellation in the period from April 15-th, 2018 till May 31, 2018 – 50% discharge (not including bank fees).
- In case of cancellation after May 31-st, 2018 – 100% discharge.
- The registration is considered as completed after the payment.

3.5. Participation in the IMRC-2018 may be paid by bank transfer from an organization or a private person. All payments are made in Russian rubles or in euros.



4. The Coordinator reserves the right to make changes in the program of the IMRC-2018.

5. The Participant is personally responsible for their health conditions and safety while participating at the IMRC-2018. The Participant must strictly follow the safety rules and regulations at the venues of IMRC-2018.

6. Terms and conditions of providing and processing information, related to participation in the IMRC-2018.

6.1. "Information" — any materials (messages, data, including personal records) presented by the IMRC-2018 Participants, including data in the application for participation and registration forms.

6.2. The Participant guarantees that the given Information is not a commercial, personal, professional, family, official, or other type of secret of the Participant and other parties, nor is it national security information, and that it is authentic, full, sufficient, and he/she has the right to provide it for processing according to the given terms and conditions.

6.3. Upon request of the IMRC-2018 Coordinator, the Participant is obliged to immediately give his/her consent to process personal information, in written form, and according to the regulations of the Russian Federation.



6.4. The Coordinator guarantees that all supplied information will be used solely in accordance with the existing legislation and in accordance with the objectives of the IMRC-2018. Before registering and providing information, the Participant confirms that he/she is familiar with the given terms and conditions, and fully agrees with them and the procedure of receiving and processing of Information.
